Install updates.



Update antivirus and anti-malware tools, too.



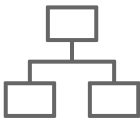
Uninstall unnecessary software from your personal computer.



Use the virtual private network (VPN) at all times.



Turn off automatic connections on your Wi-Fi.



Separate your network.



Lock your computer.



Create a different user account for family and/or friends.



Use a password manager.



Ask your IT person about securing the DNS settings on your personal computer.



Update your softphone software.



Ensure secure browser configuration.



Use Mozilla® Firefox® or Google® Chrome™ as your browser.
